CONSTITUTION PROJECT

To demonstrate understanding of the amendments to the U.S. Constitution, students will depict the 27 amendments using some form of representation other than text alone. This could include, but is not limited to:

- Hand Drawings of the amendments.
- Using borrowed images to create a slide show or other presentation for (e.g. Power Point, Prezi, Google Presentations, etc.). All images must be properly cited.
- Create a comic book.
- Create a Poster Board.
- Make a movie or movie clips representing the amendments.

The following items must be included for each amendment:

- Each amendment must be titled.
- Each amendment must be clearly marked with the amendment number.
- Each amendment will have an alternative form of representation aside from just text.
- Each amendment should include a brief description, which describes the image in the student's own words. **No plagiarized work will be accepted.** Cite all resources used to obtain the information.
- The first amendment must include five pictures illustrating the five major parts of the amendment (freedom of religion, speech, press, peaceful assembly, and petition). This is the only image in which there **must** be multiple images.
